However, your MP in Parliament is responsible for so much more than this. MPs often vote on the same political issue in different ways many times. . Ask your candidates which way they would have voted on these and other questions had they been MPs at the time.*

- * A law to force the Government to state the impact of any change in income tax (such as 10p tax) according to each income group when it is proposed 25/06/2007.
- * A law to force the Government to publish a 10 year cost and benefit estimate of the ID Cards system, including amount of money spent so far 13/2/2006
- * A law to create a renewable energy tariff to pay household consumers for electricity generated from solar power and put back into the national grid 30/4/2008
- * A law to force the government to hold an independent inquiry into events leading up to the March 2003 invasion of Iraq and its aftermath 25/3/2008
- * A law to require a ballot among parents before a community school could be changed to a foundation school 23 May 2006A law to make the House of Lords fully elected 7 March 2007
